## **Subject Enrichment Activities**

## **English - Pre-Writing Activities for the Fine Motor Development - Mont I**

Our young learners engaged in a variety of fun and skill building prewriting exercises to develop their fine motor control and early writing skills!

**Sand Tray Letter Formation:** Using fingers and tools, children traced letters in trays filled with salt. This tactile method reinforces letter recognition and muscle memory.







Stick Pattern Tracing: With the help of ice-cream sticks and zig zag lines, children followed patterns which enhanced their focus, visual tracking and pattern recognition.

Gross Motor Line Walking: To build balance and spatial awareness, children practiced walking along zig zag lines marked on floor an important foundation for controlled movements used in writing.

**Tracing Letter on Carboard:** Children practiced letter formation by tracing over thick outlines using markers. This helped strengthen their pencil grip and hand eye coordination.

Through these hands-on activities, our little ones are steadily the strength and control needed for confident writing in future.

#### **EVS - Healthy and Unhealthy food - Mont II**

Our curious little children explored the concept of healthy and unhealthy foods through hands -on activity. They enthusiastically identified different food items placed in containers, learning to make better food choices in a fun and interactive way. This engaging session not only helped children understand the importance of good nutrition but also encouraged social interaction and meaningful learning through play.
