English - Mont I

Letter Tracing Activity

Children actively participated in the letter tracing activity where they practiced tracing letters on the board. This engaging exercise helped them improve their fine motor skills, hand eye coordination, and letter recognition. The activity also made learning fun and encouraged confidence in writing skills.

Maths - Mont I

Counting Beads - Learning Numbers Through Play

Little learners enjoyed a hands on activity with colourful beads, enhancing their number recognition and counting skills while developing their fine motor coordination.

Maths - Mont II

Number Matching Activity

Children enthusiastically participate in a number - matching activity using wooden puzzles. They identified and matched numbers with corresponding dot patterns. The activity helped them to strengthen their counting and number recognition skills.

Building Numbers with Ten Frames.

Learners enhanced their number sense with an engaging Tens and Ones activity. Using ten frames, they recognised numbers, arranged the correct tens and ones, and visually constructed numbers. This hands-on approach made learning place value clear, interactive and fun.
