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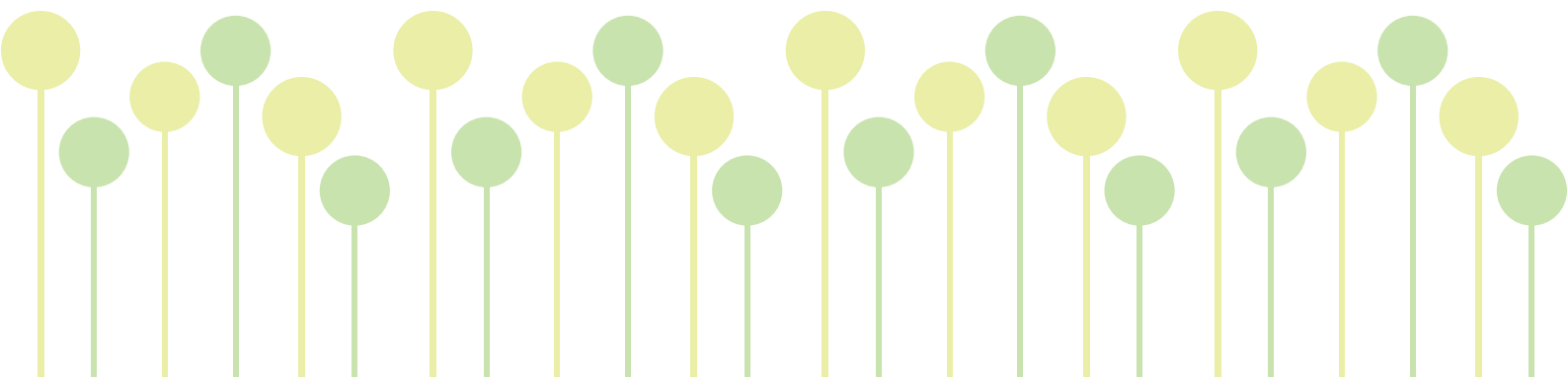

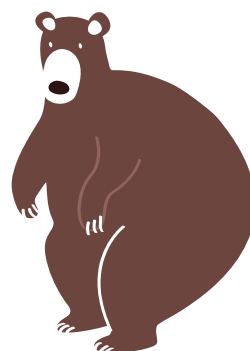
Chairman Sir's Visit

All India Ryan Championship

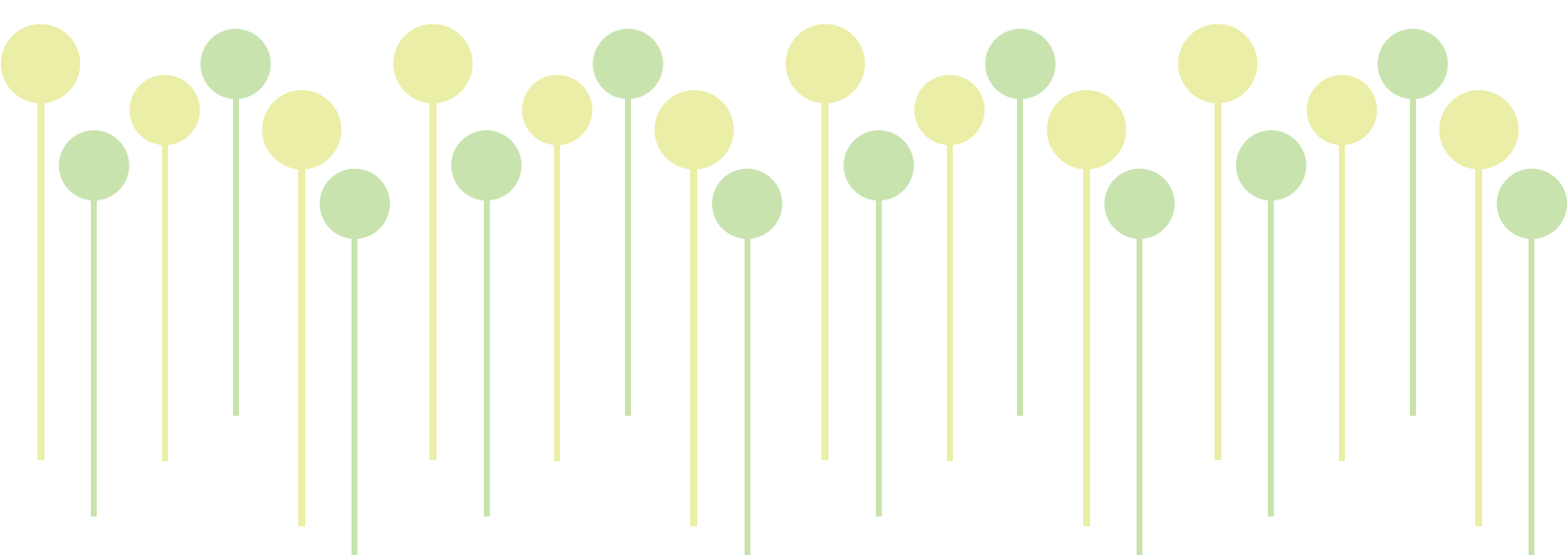

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The students also wrote 3 ways to conserve tigers. grade VI to VII the students did presentations about tigers.

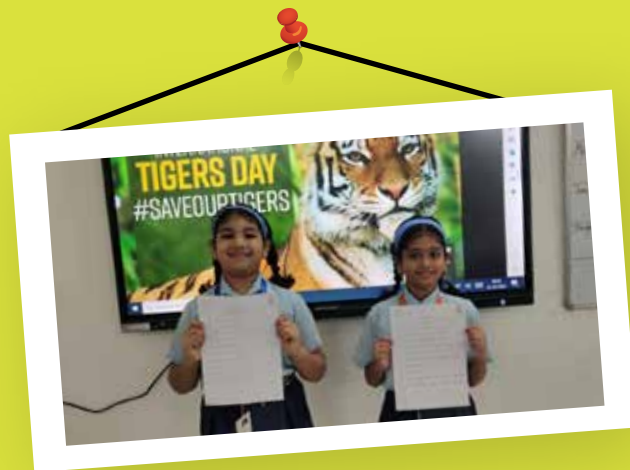

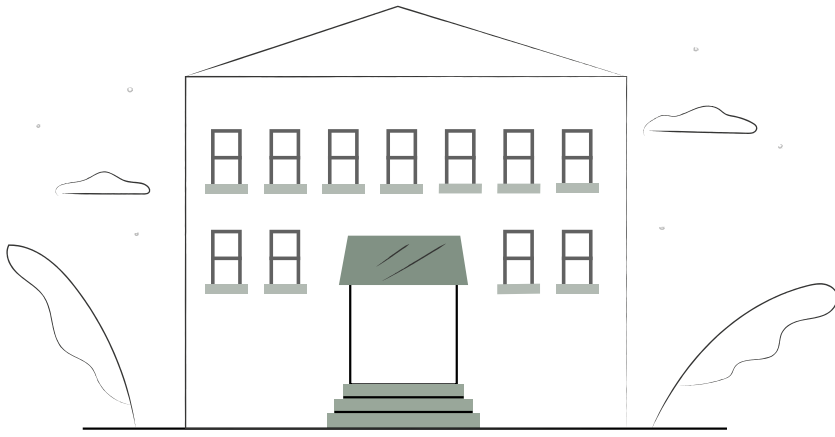
Student Achievements
