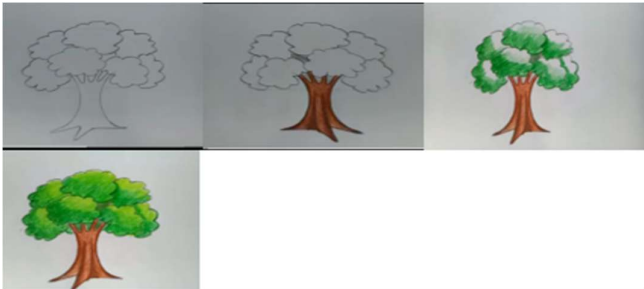

Mont II and III	Title: Paper Tearing Activity - Hand Tree A paper tearing activity of a hand tree is a fun and creative way to develop fine motor skills and encourage artistic expression in young children. Here's how to draft and conduct this activity step-by-step: <u>Objective:</u> - To enhance fine motor skills through tearing paper - To encourage creativity and awareness of nature <u>Learning Outcome:</u> - Children will recognize the structure of a tree. They will develop hand strength and coordination. They will express themselves through art and craft.
	Tracing the Hand (5 minutes): * Teacher will ask each child to place one hand on the white sheet. * Teacher will help them trace around their arm using a pencil. This will be the trunk and branches of the tree. Tearing the Green Paper (10 minutes): * Next, teacher will ask each child to tear green paper into small bits. * Teacher will ask them to paste these around the fingers (branches) to represent leaves.

STD III to V	Activity Title: Newspaper Tree Collage - Reuse to Save the Earth! Objective: • To promote the reuse of old materials • To encourage creativity and environmental awareness • To develop fine motor and group collaboration skills. Learning Outcome: Students will understand how reuse helps reduce waste They will express creativity through eco-friendly materials They will take pride in turning waste into art Materials Needed: • Old newspapers • Chart paper or A4 sheets (as the base) • Scissors • Glue stick or Fevicol • Brown and green crayons or markers Introduction (5-10 minutes) Begin with a short talk: • Why is reusing important? • What can we do with old newspapers? • Show a sample or picture of a newspaper tree collage. Label & Display Students write a sentence below: • "I reused paper to save a tree!" • Display all collages on the board or corridor boards under the title "We Reuse for a Greener Planet!"
