On account of *World Earth Day*, we are excited to announce creative competitions for our Montessori children to engage in activities that celebrate and raise awareness about our beautiful planet.

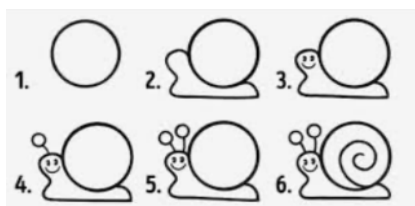
Please find the details below:

 *The best-drawn snail will be awarded.*

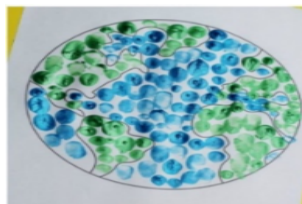
 **Materials to be sent by parents:** Crayons, pencil, eraser, sharpener.
