STD III to V	Breathing and Mindfulness Exercises <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teach fun breathing patterns like:• Bee Breath (Bhramari) - Humming like a bee• Rainbow Breathing - Pretend to draw a rainbow with arms while breathing

It was introduced by the then French Minister of Art and Culture, **Jack Lange**, and organised by **Maurice Fleuret**, a French composer, music journalist, and radio producer. Since then, this day has grown into a global celebration of music, uniting people through rhythm and melody.

To honour this special occasion, we have planned a series of creative and musical competitions across different grades:

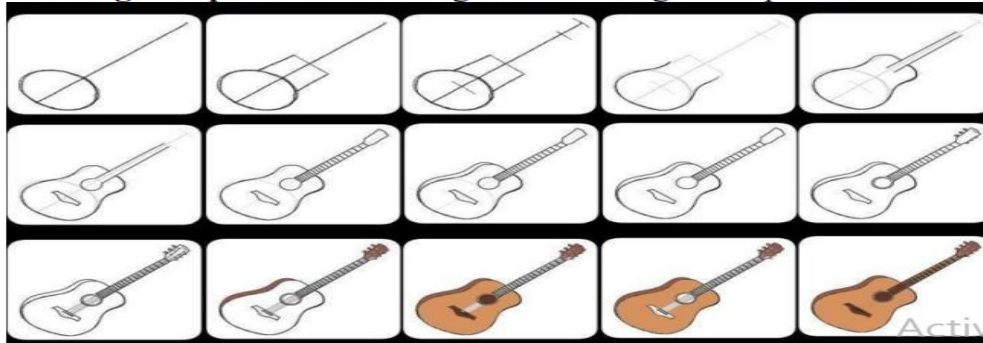
Grade I & II – Young Musicians Competition
