Rakhi Making

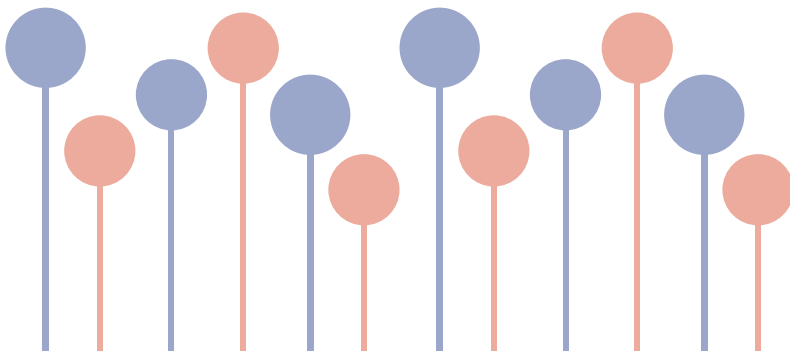

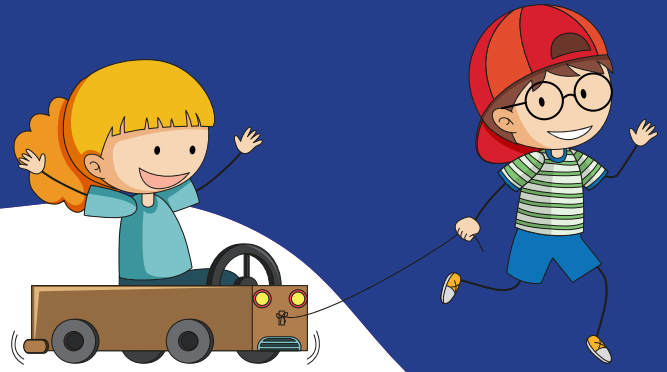
Introduction of Basic Circuits (Copper Tape)

Our Mont III students were introduced to the **fundamental concept of electric circuits** in a fun and hands-on way. By using **copper tape as a conductor**, a coin cell battery as a power source, and an LED as the output device, students designed a simple working circuit on paper. They learned that electricity flows only through a **closed loop**, and that proper connections are necessary for the LED to glow. The activity also helped them understand the

importance of conductors, polarity, and energy transfer. Beyond the science, it encouraged **creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork** as students experimented with different circuit designs and corrected mistakes. This project served as an exciting introduction to electronics and laid the foundation for more complex projects in the future.

Tirangaa

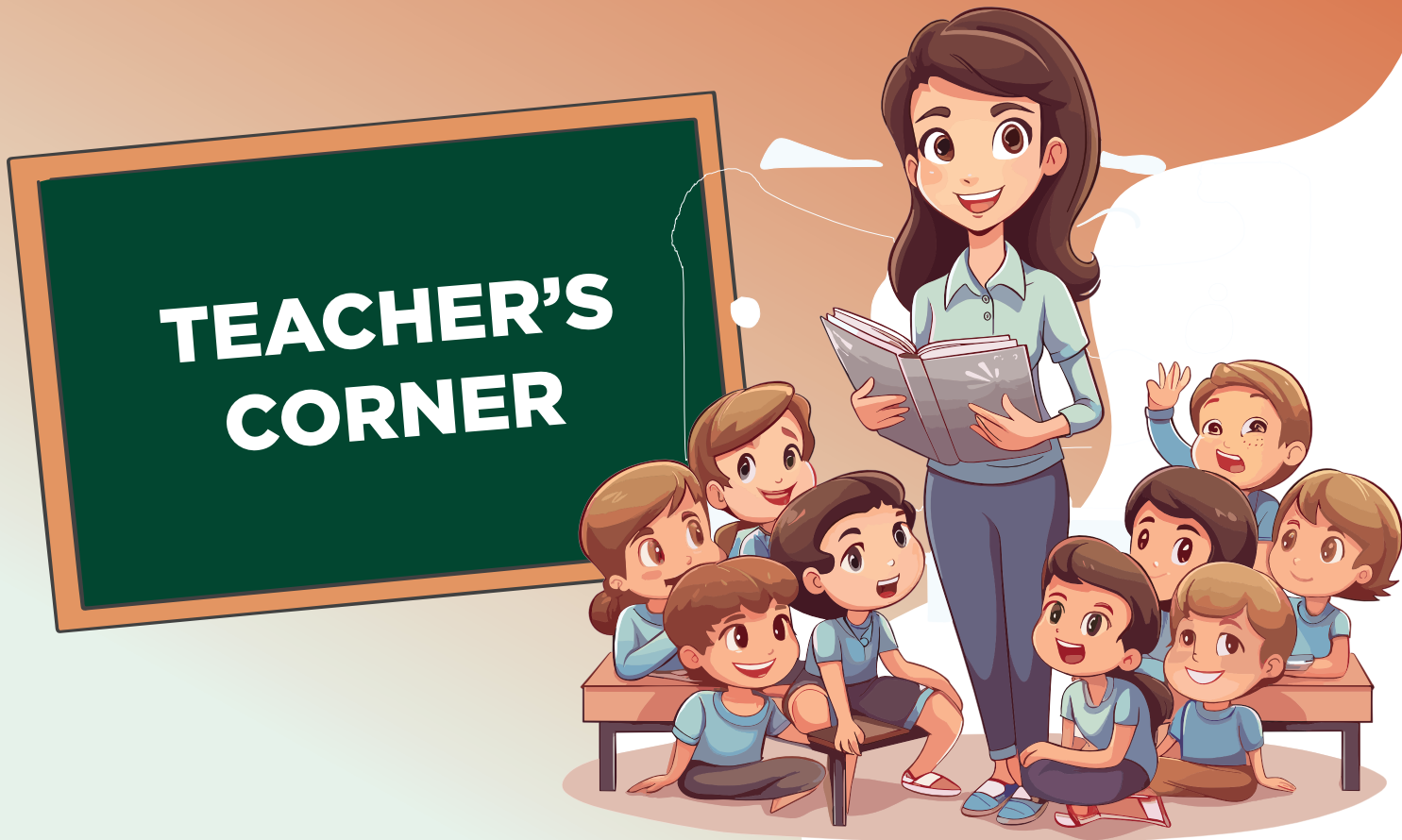

Our little Montessori champs won hearts with puppet shows in Finger Tales, weaving stories with confidence and expression.

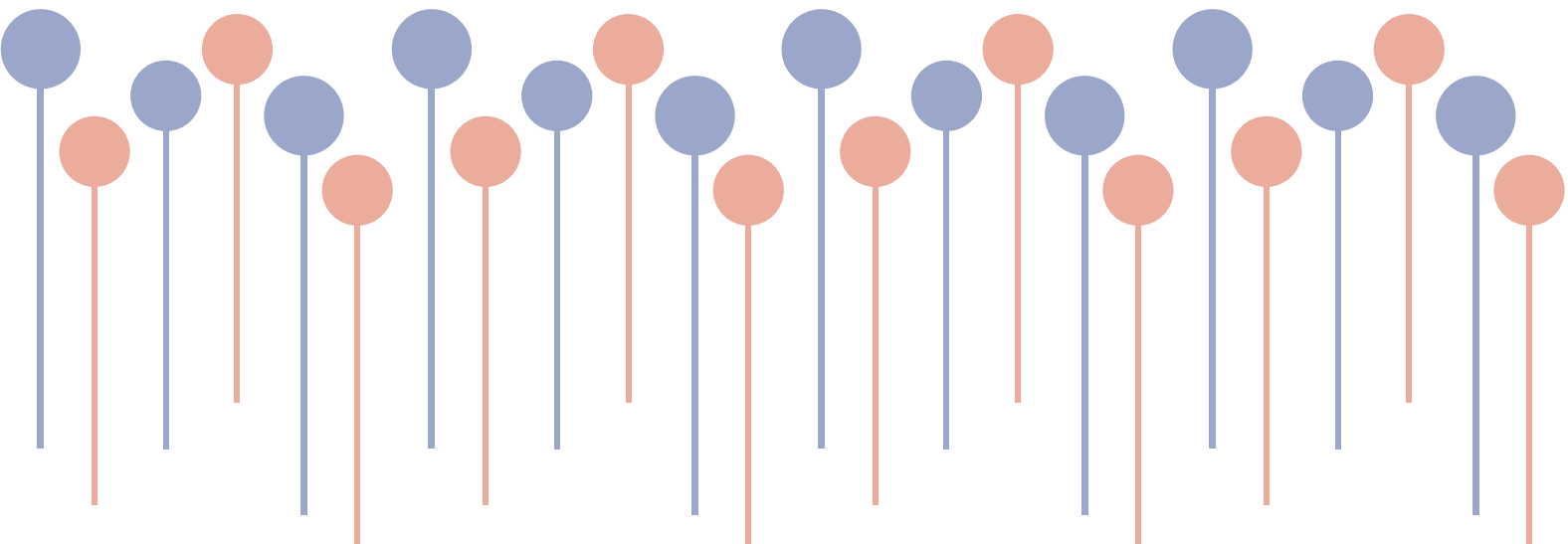
Congratulations to all winners and participants! Tirangaa 2025 was not just a competition, but a celebration of imagination, teamwork, and dreams for a brighter India.
