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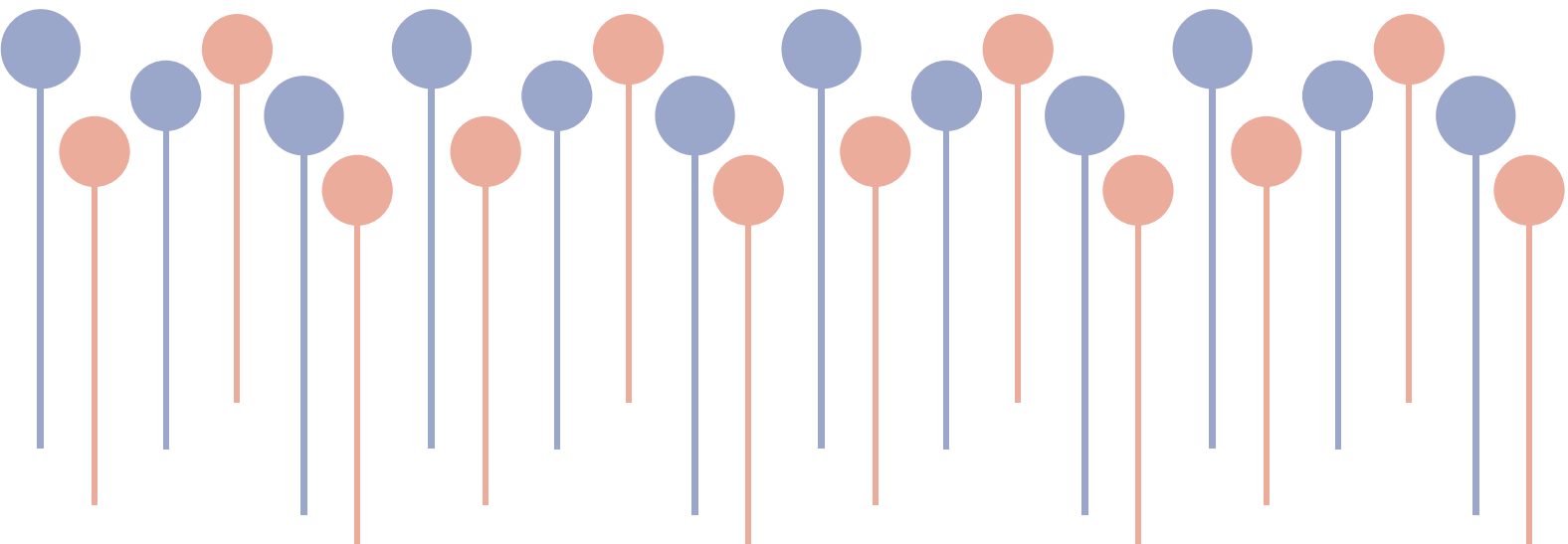


Value of the month: Creativity

Mont II

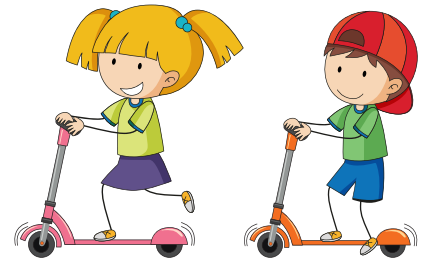

Innovation Lab Activity Mont III

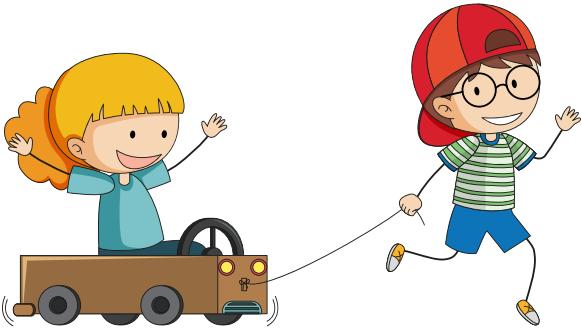

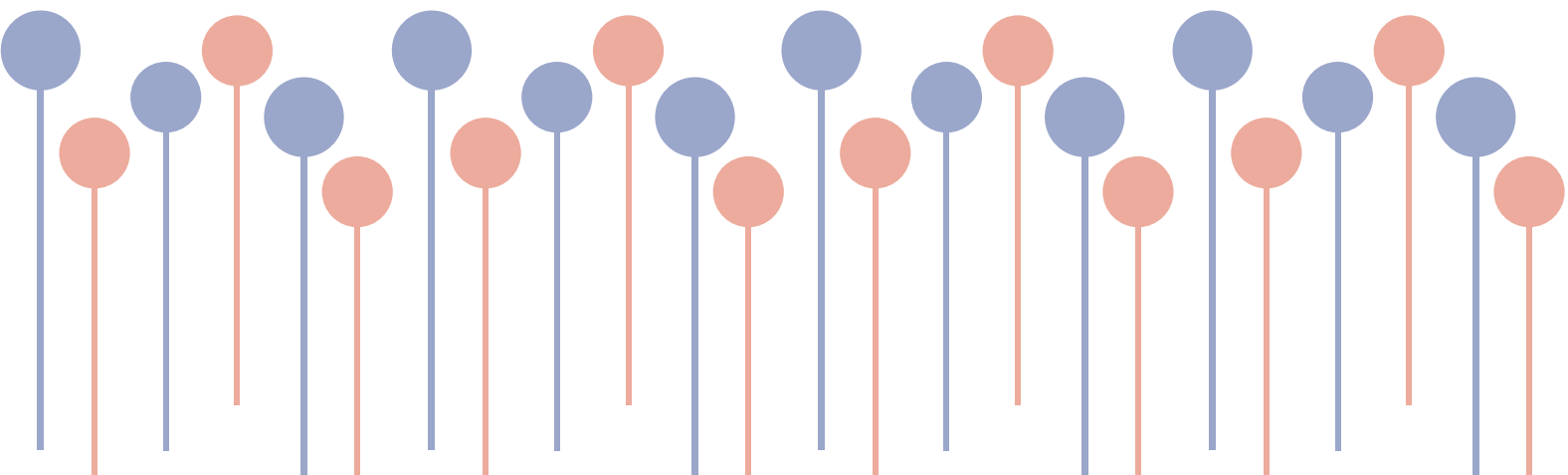


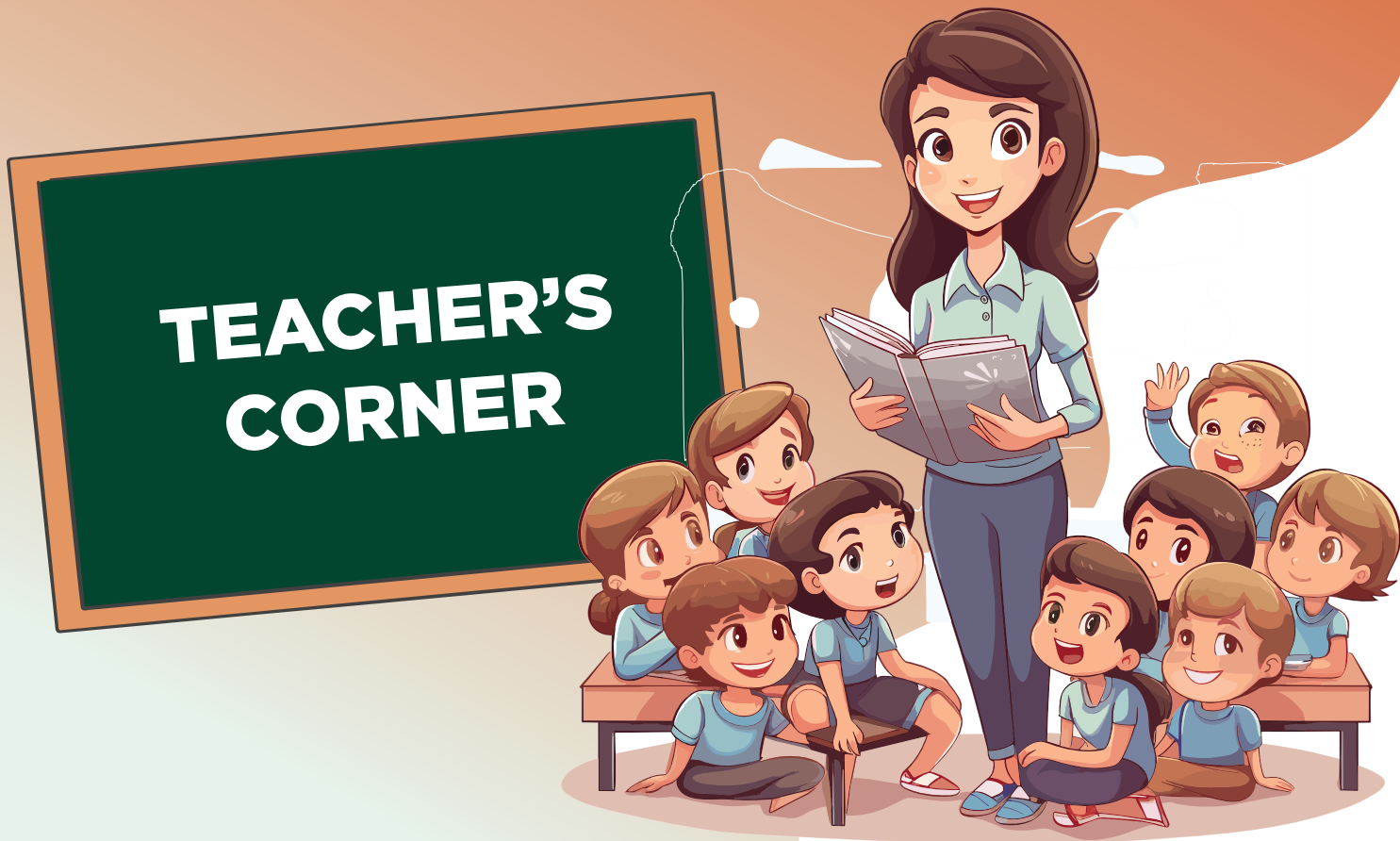


PARENT'S CORNER
