## ANNEXURE-A

Sr.no.	Name of the Activity	Description
1	Revival of Lost Art	This initiative is an effort to renew and inform students about Indian art and craft traditions that are dying. These include various kinds of historical art forms like patta chitra, warli art, block printing, etc.
2	Home Science	In this initiative learners explore aspects of 'better living' in terms of food and nutrition, personal hygiene, peer communication, housekeeping.
3	Literary	This programme can help students develop their creativity and imagination by exposing them to different styles, genres, and forms of writing. This can help them develop their own writing skills and express themselves more effectively.
4	Eco and Gardening	This programme provide students with hands-on learning experiences that can help them better understand concepts such as plant growth, soil health, and ecosystem dynamics. This can help students develop a deeper appreciation and understanding of the natural world.
5	Coding Club	This club exposes children to new technology and helps them gain in-depth knowledge of coding.
6	Foreign Language Club	In this club students learn a foreign language and the culture of its country of origin.
7	Helen O'Grady Speech and Drama Club	This club encourages learners to be creative and confident individuals, able to express themselves using drama techniques to hone communication skills.
