- Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 30 As per rule no 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'

School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.

The contents must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If prescribed books found having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.

As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

- 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with 37 the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV)
- The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws. 38
- It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE 39 schools
- The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ 40 Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect

- That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.
- That the employees of the school will be given pay and allowances and other prescribed benefits as provided for under section 10(i) of the DSEA, 1973 and Rule 125 of D.S.E.R. 1973. The staff should be paid full salary with allowances through cross cheque before 7th of every month.
- 6. That the school shall not run any unrecognised classes or conduct any other activities within the school premises as per Rule 50 of DSER, 1973 and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place.
- 7: That the school shall dispense with the services of unmalified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately, and the remained staff strength must be complete in all respects as per norma.
